The top 5% of journals have impact factors approximately equal to or greater than 6 (610 journals or 4.9% of the journals tracked by JCR). Approximately two-thirds of the journals tracked by JCR have a 2017 impact factor equal to or greater than 1.

Journal Impact Factors

What are impact factors and how would I use them? A journal's impact factor is based on how often articles published in that journal during the previous two years (e.g. 2000 and 2001) were cited by articles published

in a particular year (e.g. 2002). The higher a journal's impact factor, the more frequently articles in that journal are cited by other articles.

Journal Impact Factors | Annual Reviews

The 5 year journal impact factor is the average number of times, the articles published in a journal get cited in last 5 years. It is calculated by dividing the number of citations received with the total number of articles published in previous five years.

The 2018 Impact Factor, for example, was calculated as follows: A = the number of times articles which published in 2016-2017 were cited in indexed journals during 2018 B = the total number of research and review articles from the journal published in 2016-2017. 2018 Impact Factor = A/B
