The Gossamer Years begins in 954 ce and covers a period of 20 years. The diary is written by a frustrated and desperately lonely woman, who recounts her unhappy relationship with a senior official in the Heian court. This was written earlier than the more famous Pillowbook of Sei Shonagon and is different in tone and intention.

Here he translates the diary of a 10th-century noblewoman known as “the mother of Michitsuna” that covers 21 years and significantly illuminates Japanese marriage customs during the Heian period.
