Individuals can also judge the intensity of exercise by the RPE, which can be equated with the desired HR during laboratory exercise and activities. The original scale is a 15-grade category scale that ranges from 6-20, with a verbal description at every odd number, beginning at 7 (very, very light) and progressing to 19 (very, very hard).

Rheumatoid arthritis is an autoimmune disease that causes chronic joint inflammation.Autoimmune diseases occur when the body's tissues are mistakenly attacked by their own immune system. In RA, multiple joints are usually, but not always, affected (polyarthritis) in a symmetrical pattern.; Joint damage can occur early and does not always correlate with the severity of RA symptoms and signs.

Polymyalgia rheumatica is a clinical diagnosis . A careful history and physical examination are crucial in distinguishing this syndrome from other disorders that may present similarly, especially seronegative RA and paraneoplastic syndrome.
