Larger bats are generally frugivorous (fruit eating), while smaller species tend to be insectivorous (insect eating). Blood-sucking vampire bats do not occur in Southeast Asia, but are confined to Central and South America. Mega-colonies of *Miniopterus* or Bent-winged bats occur where limestone caves afford sufficient roosting space.
