Low-Income Energy Assistance Program (LEAP)

The LIHEAP statute (Section 2605(b)(2)(B) or Assurance 2) says that to be eligible a household must have an income that does not exceed the greater of 150 percent of the federal poverty guideline (FPG) or 60 percent of the state median income (SMI) level.(The FPG is the baseline of 100 percent of federal poverty, adjusted each year by the federal government.) In addition, income eligibility levels may not be set below 110 percent of the FPG.

For families more than 18 persons add \$522.50 to 30 day income or \$6,270 to annual income for each additional person. These figures are based on the 2017 Federal Poverty Guidelines published in the US Department of Health and Human Services in the Federal Register/Volume 81/Number 19/January 31, 2017.

Income Guidelines. The LIHEAP statute establishes 150 percent of the poverty level as the maximum income level allowed in determining LIHEAP income eligibility, except where 60 percent of state median income is higher. Income eligibility criteria for LIHEAP may not be set lower than 110 percent of the poverty.

To be eligible, a household gross income must be at or below 175% of the Federal Poverty Level, (please refer to income guidelines listed below), and pay more than 3% of its annual income for electric, or more than 3% for natural gas. If a household has electric heat, it must spend more than 6% of its annual income on electricity to be eligible.
