Councils across the UK are funded by a combination of central government grants and local taxes. The balance between these funding sources varies. In England, in 2018/19 [2] , 50% of funding came from central government grants, 31% from council tax, 18% from business rates revenue (which is collected locally but then redistributed via a nationally-run system), and 1% from council reserves.
