In Lords of All the World Anthony Pagden compares ideologies of empire in early modern Spain, Britain, and France, almost exclusively (despite his title) in relation to New World conquest and settlement. While not unmindful of how those "languages of empire" shaped and adapted to American colonial realities, Pagden pays the balance of his attention to metropolitan intellectual debates about the morals and ideals of expansion.
