Cut a piece of freezer paper to 8.5" by 11", or use the already precut and sized freezer paper made for printers and glue or tape it to your card stock shiny side up. The cardstock will help stabilize the freezer paper so it doesn't get jammed in your printer or smear the ink when it doesn't pull properly from a slippery sheet of freezer paper.

How to Make Freezer Paper Stencils | the Polka Dot Chair  
Iron the fabric to the freezer paper. Once you have the freezer paper cut to size, you can iron your fabric to it. Place the wrong side of the fabric on the waxed side of the paper. Use the hottest setting your fabric can take, and, with a dry iron, press the fabric to the freezer paper. I use a cotton setting on the iron for most of what I do.

DIY T-Shirt Painting- with Freezer Stencil Paper - The ...  
Step By Step Instructions to create your own custom t-shirt. First, print your design onto the freezer paper. If you have an inkjet printer, simply trim your freezer paper to letter or A4 size and stick it into the printer. It's very important that you print on the matte paper side, NOT the waxy side.

Set your iron to the dry and high setting, lay the fabric on top of the freezer paper, and make sure the shiny side of the freezer paper is facing the fabric. Iron the fabric smoothly onto the freezer paper so they adhere.

Make sure you get it really scraped off before lifting up your freezer paper to ensure all of your wording/picture comes off. Fun DIY project right. Great to customize a cutting board like this that you could use as a gift or a project for a Boy or Girl scout troop too....just perfect it beforehand.
