Malaria should be suspected in children with any febrile illness if they have travelled to a region where malaria is endemic; Artemether-lumefantrine is the treatment of choice for uncomplicated Plasmodium falciparum malaria; Infection with P. vivax, P. ovale (or an unknown species) must be treated with primaquine to prevent relapse

The infecting Plasmodium species: Determination of the infecting Plasmodium species for treatment purposes is important for three main reasons. Firstly, P. falciparum and P. knowlesi infections can cause rapidly progressive severe illness or death while the other species, P. vivax, P. ovale, or P. malariae, are less likely to cause severe manifestations.

1.1 Malaria is a life-threatening infection caused by Plasmodium species and transmitted by some species of anopheles mosquitoes. According to the WHO malaria report, there were 212 million new cases of malaria worldwide in 2015 (range 148:304 million) and an estimated 429 000 malaria deaths (range 235 000:639 000) worldwide.
