The engine is then barred over 90° to in the normal direction of rotation and a reading of the micrometer taken. The process is then repeated with the pin at top dead centre (TDC) and again with the crank pin at 270°. Finally the engine is barred over to as close to bottom dead centre as the micrometer will allow and a final reading taken.
