UCSNP EVERYDAY MATHEMATICS
IEP Goals: Given tally marks which contain a visual counting guide, STUDENT will count tally marks up to twenty by matching the correct number card, as part of an independent work task, with 80% accuracy, in 4 out of 5 opportunities, by MONTH, YEAR.

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
