Loosely organized lymphoid tissue and structures of the intestinal tract where 80% of the immune system is located. Paneth Cells. Located in the small intestine these cells are part of the antimicrobial defenses. They phagocytize bacteria and produce antibacterial proteins called defensins and lysozyme.

Small Intestinal Bacterial Overgrowth (SIBO): Symptoms ...

In an infection, the microbial agent is ingested, colonizes the gut, and then produces toxins that damage host cells. In an intoxication, bacteria produce toxins in the food before it is ingested. In either case, the toxins cause damage to the cells lining the gastrointestinal tract, typically the colon.
