Update on the NCEP ATP-III emerging cardiometabolic risk factors

Background Adult Treatment Panel of the National Cholesterol Education Program issued their third guideline for cholesterol management in 2001 - known as ATP III. Since publication, 5 major clinical trials of statin therapy have been published. This has resulted in an addendum to the ATP III guideline. Next update (ATP IV) expected in 2013.

ATP III Guidelines At-A-Glance Quick Desk Reference

2013 ACC/AHA guideline and the ATP III guidelines are the introduction of the Pooled Cohort equations, the elimination of LDL-C treatment targets, and the lowering of the threshold at which statins should be considered to an estimated 10-year absolute risk of 7.5%. The differences are summarized in Table 1.

Then and Now: ATP III vs. IV - American College of Cardiology

Adult Treatment Panel (ATP), an expert panel to supervise cholesterol management was set up under the aegis of National Cholesterol Education Program (NCEP) in 1985. Since then NCEP-ATP has been revising and framing guidelines to enable clinician to deliver better treatment and educate general people.

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
