AWPA's standards are the only standards for treated wood directly listed in the IRC and IBC, so the first thing to do is look for "AWPA" and the applicable standard, usually "U1" on the end tag. It's also important to look for the preservative code and retention (amount of preservative retained in the wood), for example, "ACQ-D" or "CA-C".

The AWPA Book of Standards states, "Standard U1 is the primary standard for specifiers, such as architects and engineers, but also for end users and building code officials.
