Always remember that each hospital is different and the procedure from one place to another will vary. Always consult the lab manual or procedure manual at your facility to be sure that the nursing responsibilities have been carried out properly. Test: BMR, Basal Metabolism Rate. Normal Values: + 5% probably means slightly overactive thyroid
