Hypercalcaemia of malignancy can result from: humoral hypercalcaemia of malignancy (characterised by tumour secretion of parathyroid hormone-related peptide [PTHrP]); local osteolytic hypercalcaemia (characterised by local release of factors, including PTHrP, by bony metastases that promote osteoclast differentiation and function); calcitriol (1,25-dihydroxyvitamin D)-mediated hypercalcaemia ...
