Alfred Wegener's theory of "continental drift" directs attention to the origin of the continents, and in Wegener's first publication on the topic this emphasis was reflected in the title: Die Entstehung der Kontinente (1912). By 1915, Wegener's thinking had already evolved to an understanding that the "origin of continents," was also, of necessity, the "origin of the oceans."

5.2 Origin of the Oceans – Introduction to Oceanography

The World Ocean is the habitat of 230,000 known species, but because much of it is unexplored, the number of species that exist in the ocean is much larger, possibly over two million. The origin of Earth's oceans is unknown: oceans are thought to have formed in the Hadean eon and may have been the cause for the emergence of life.

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
