Subpart K) on the comprehensive information found in NFPA 70E. 29 CFR 1910.333(a) states that employers must employ safety-related work practices to prevent electrical shock or other injuries resulting from either direct or indirect electrical contact.

When it comes to electrical safety, OSHA refers to NFPA 70E, which requires employers to conduct an electrical hazard assessment consisting of a shock hazard analysis and an arc flash hazard analysis before work is performed on live equipment operating at 50 volts and higher.

OSHA will keep all identities confidential. Exercise their rights under the law without retaliation, including reporting an injury or raising health and safety concerns with their employer or OSHA. If a worker has been retaliated against for using their rights, they must file a complaint with OSHA as soon as possible, but no later than 30 days.

According to the OSHA Fact Sheet, "Working Safely with Electricity," it is required to use only cords that meet OSHA standards and are approved by a laboratory, such as Underwriters Laboratory, or UL. Approved extension cords have tags stating the testing organization. OSHA regulations require three-wire type extension cords having strain relief.
