Paraphrasing is not summarising. Summarising is when you give an overview of the author's key ideas as a whole, or provide an overview of a topic. A summary is usually shorter than the original piece of writing. It might state the ideas of a paragraph in one simple sentence. A summary tells you about the whole passage.
