Acoustic phonetics: the study of the physical transmission of speech sounds from the speaker to the listener. Auditory phonetics: the study of the reception and perception of speech sounds by the listener. The International Phonetic Alphabet (IPA) is used as the basis for the phonetic transcription of speech. It is based on the Latin alphabet and is able to transcribe most features of speech ...

Although the word 'phonics' sounds similar to the words 'phonetics' and 'phonology', it is actually a system for relating sounds to spellings in order to develop reading and writing skills. The phonics system contains 42 'letter sounds' which relate to the most common spelling patterns in English, and use letter combinations to relate sounds to spellings.

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Phonetics vs. Phonology. 1. Phonetics vs. phonology. Phonetics deals with the production of speech sounds by humans, often without prior knowledge of the language being spoken. Phonology is about patterns of sounds, especially different patterns of sounds in different languages, or within each language, different patterns of sounds in different positions in words etc.

In this use, phonics is regarded as a simplified form of phonetics [fʔ-nʔt'ʔks], which is the scientific study of speech sounds.
