A common way we measure poverty is the federal poverty level, a number set by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services. But social welfare researchers say it would take an income of about twice that amount to achieve basic financial security. — U.S. Census Bureau. 1 kid in 5 lives in poverty compared to 1 in 8 adults.
