### OEE (Overall Equipment Effectiveness) - Lean Production

Measuring OEE is a manufacturing best practice. By measuring OEE and the underlying losses, you will gain important insights on how to systematically improve your manufacturing process. OEE is the single best metric for identifying losses, benchmarking progress, and improving the productivity of manufacturing equipment (i.e., eliminating waste).

### How to measure effectiveness of production lines?

Rather, OEE is best used to measure the performance and analyze the losses on a particular piece of equipment so that they can (1) be understood and (2) be addressed. At the top level, it measures good output against planned good output, using the planned production hours and ideal cycle time. That's a measure of how the equipment is performing.

### Overall Equipment Effectiveness (OEE) Calculator

OEE, defined as a measure of overall equipment performance, identifies six major losses for ineffective performance of a production line based on its Availability, Performance and the Quality rate of the output. The Availability of equipment is affected by Downtime Losses – 1. Equipment Failure and 2.

Planned Shutdown – Not part of OEE (Overall Equipment Effectiveness) Calculation. Downtime Loss - Operating Time to Planned Production Time ratio is called availability, when a process runs without any stoppage there will be 100% availability.

Overall equipment effectiveness (OEE) is a measure of how well a manufacturing operation is utilized (facilities, time and material) compared to its full potential, during the periods when it is scheduled to run. It identifies the percentage of manufacturing time that is truly productive.

### Production Losses: How to Find and Reduce Them

OEE (Overall Equipment Effectiveness) is a “best practices” metric that identifies the percentage of planned production time that is truly productive. An OEE score of 100% represents perfect production:

### OEE | Overall Equipment Effectiveness

Sum up the planned operating time for the given production equipment within the given period. For instance, if you want to calculate downtime losses for the month of May and you were operating for 20 days in May for eight hours per day, multiply 20 by 8 to get 160.

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
