For the competency Communicates, the teacher's judgment with respect to the competency level attained by the student can be qualified by adding the symbol + to the level that corresponds most closely to the competency demonstrated by the student.

How the accreditors evaluate a competency-based program could directly determine the decision-making process the institutions takes in designing their program. At the same time, various accreditation staff are academic subject matter experts but may not have experience with competency-based program models to properly evaluate the rigor or quality of the program.
