Public Education Expenditures, Growth and Income Inequality

In response to the question: 'How much is inequality reduced by progressive taxation and government spending?', their answer is that, when they adjust household incomes 'comprehensively' for the impact of government revenue and expenditure, the Gini coefficient (which measures income inequality) is reduced from 0.77 to 0.59.
