A Clear Instructional Arc Each reading unit represents about five to six weeks of teaching, structured into three or four "bends in the road." Rather than tackling the entire journey all at once, it's easier to embark on this series of shorter, focused bends, pausing between each to regroup and prepare for the next.

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Guided small-group or individual instruction in which children have opportunities to work individually, in pairs, or in small groups on activities related to the unit's final project (roughly 20-30 minutes) Whole-class review and reflection to clarify any confusions, review key terms, and often to share student work (roughly 10 minutes)
