When a relapse occurs, feelings of guilt and self-blame may only worsen the situation. Relapse Prevention Therapy (RPT, Marlatt & Donovan, 2005) is a type of cognitive-behavioral therapy. RPT aims to limit or prevent relapses by helping the therapy participant to anticipate circumstances that are likely to provoke a relapse.

Aftercare/Discharge Planning Session: An Aftercare/Discharge Planning Session is held with each offender before final completion to: Review Progress, Finalize the Violence Relapse Prevention Plan, Complete an Aftercare Plan, Document Completion of the Domestic Violence Program for the appropriate Court, Probation/Parole Office, Child Protective Service Agency, etc., and to say Goodbye unless the offender is chooses to continue in voluntary treatment.

6.26.7.4 Relapse Prevention. Relapse prevention is based on and adapted from the relapse prevention model developed by Marlatt (1985) for alcoholics.
