Performing RMAN Tablespace Point-in-Time Recovery (TSPITR)

Recovering tables and table partitions from RMAN backups is useful in the following scenarios: You need to recover a very small number of tables to a particular point in time. In this situation, TSPITR is not the most effective solution because it moves all the objects in the tablespace to a specified point in time.

To perform an incomplete recovery on a tablespace which consists of one or more datafiles, RMAN uses the Tablespace Point-in-Time Recovery (TSPITR) feature.

If RMAN uses only a control file, however, repeated TSPITR is only possible after dropping the tablespace because the control file does not have the tablespace history. In this case, RMAN only knows about the current set of tablespaces. The tablespace on which TSPITR was performed has a creation time equal to the time it was brought online.

RMAN starts to clone and recovers the database until the specified scn value by skipping the tbl_skip tablespace, Read Only and Offline tablespaces. With the SKIP TABLESPACE clause , the tablespaces can be excluded from the duplicate database, but not the system tablespace or undo tablespace which contains rollback or undo segments.

Performing Complete Restore and Recovery of Databases

The backup_ts_users.rman command file works well, but it's too specific. It forces the output of the backup to one specific directory and backs up only one tablespace (USERS). If you want to back up to a different location or back up a different tablespace, you have to create a new script.
