Roald Dahl's Boy: Tales of Childhood lesson plans

Dahl's 1984 memoir, *Boy: Tales of Childhood*, offers a glimpse of British boyhood experiences involving sweet shops and harsh headmasters that seem the stuff of his outlandish fiction. Organized chronologically from before Dahl's birth in 1916 to the beginning of WWII, *Boy* is not, Dahl states, an autobiography, but rather "a number of things [that] happened to me that I have never forgotten."

Study Guide Comparing and Contrasting Matilda the Book vs ...

Dahl was partly inspired to write *The Witches* by his experiences in Norway and the United Kingdom. As a child, he spent nearly all of his summers with family in Norway. This was his favorite part of the year. Many of the stories in his memoir, *Boy*, were based on experiences from these summers.
