So, the key question is to determine which model is appropriate. The answer is the Hausman Test. To use it we perform both the fixed and random effects regression, and then apply the Hausman Test to see if their coefficient estimates diverge significantly. If they diverge, endogeneity is at play and a fixed effects model is the best choice.
