Section 36-2 During muscle contraction, the knoblike head of a myosin filament attaches to a binding site on actin, forming a cross-bridge. Powered by ATP, the myosin cross-bridge changes shape and pulls the actin filament toward the center of the sarcomere. The cross-bridge then detaches from the actin filament, and the myosin filament moves toward another site on the actin filament, and the sarcomere contracts.
