Early collection of spousal benefits may be costly for another reason, unrelated to the reduction for age: If you've earned Social Security retirement benefits based on your own earnings and you begin collecting a spousal benefit before you reach your full retirement age, your own (unclaimed) retirement benefit no longer can increase, as it otherwise would for every month you delay claiming aft

the full retirement age (and up until age 70).
