The philosopher Aristotle separated rhetoric into three distinct methods: Logos, or logic, which comes from the head; Pathos, or emotion, which comes from the heart; Ethos, or morality, which comes from a combination of head and heart; Aristotle argued that good rhetoric involved all three of these methods.
