The Dirt On Soil Learning

More than dirt. If you were to divide a soil sample into 20 parts, 9 parts would be made up of the stuff we think of as dirt: clay, silt and sand. These are inorganic particles, which means they come from non-living sources. A full half, or 10 parts, would be equally divided between air and water.

What is Soil Video - Turtle Diary

Sandy Soil - is quite dry and light and contains larger amounts of air. Water drains through it easily. Clay Soil - contains smaller amounts of air and pieces of finely ground rock. Clay soil is very heavy and sticky when wet and water does not drain through it easily. When clay becomes wet it swells and sticks together.
