How is Precision Teaching used in learning? Precision teaching is a systematic method that is mostly performed between a student and a teacher on a one-to-one basis. These interactive sessions are suggested at least 3 times a week for approximately 10 minutes.. Precision teaching is meant to help students to think fast until they can recall the spelling of a specific word nearly instinctively.

Both sight words and high frequency words need to be recognised quickly for reading and writing to become fluent. Knowing 100 of these frequently used words gives a beginning reader about half of the words they need for reading.
