Hopping state lines has tax implications. Namely, you need to file a return in the state you live in and any states you worked in. That doesn't mean you'll pay taxes two or three times on the same income. Most states have a system to reconcile multiple state returns, via reciprocity or tax credits, but the exact process varies.

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
