The organ music of Marcel Dupre has tended to be regarded with a reverence which, for many, never warmed into affection. A reputation as a father-figure among improvisers has been bequeathed to those who never heard him unfold him impromptu canvasses. Recordings of Dupre playing his own music somehow didn't come up to the quality of the legend.
