The problem of evil is often formulated in two forms: the logical problem of evil and the evidential problem of evil. The logical form of the argument tries to show a logical impossibility in the coexistence of God and evil, [1] [4] while the evidential form tries to show that given the evil in the world, it is improbable that there is an omnipotent, omniscient, and wholly good God. 1. The Incompatibility Problem of Evil. According to 'Incompatibility' or 'Logical' versions of the Problem of Evil, E is logically incompatible with God's existence (Mackie 1955). That means that believing in E and believing in God is like believing in a five-sided square.
