The Reichsmarine (, ) was the name of the German Navy during the Weimar Republic and first two years of Nazi Germany. It was the naval branch of the Reichswehr , existing from 1919 to 1935. In 1935, it became known as the Kriegsmarine , a branch of the Wehrmacht ; a change implemented by Adolf Hitler .
