What Is A Whitewashed Tomb? The term white washed tombs was part of the 7 woes that Jesus pronounced on the Pharisees and Sadducees in Matthew 23. Matthew 23:27 "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which indeed appear beautiful outwardly, but inside are full of dead men's bones and all uncleanness.

Acts 23:3 Then Paul said to him, "God will ... - Bible Hub

In the sixth woe, Jesus claims the scribes and Pharisees are "like whitewashed tombs, which look beautiful on the outside but on the inside are full of the bones of the dead and everything unclean" (Matthew 23:27). The deadness inside of tombs is likened to the "hypocrisy and wickedness" inside the religious leaders (verse 28).

Why did Jesus rebuke the scribes and Pharisees so harshly ...

Whitewashed Tombs and Touching Dead Bodies It was ceremonially unclean for a Jew to touch a tomb. This is why they were whitewashed with lime, so they could be easily seen and not accidentally touched.

There is a rather famous, yet somewhat misunderstood, warning in the Gospels: "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs, which outwardly appear beautiful, but within are full of dead people's bones and all uncleanness.
