Test-re-test Method: Other parts are timed, so can't be split, like Math Fluency. To compensate for this, the test re-test method is used; where individuals are asked to take the test of interest and then take the same test again at a later date. The scores are then compared. The closer the scores are, the more reliable the test.

The test was revised first in 2005 as the Wechsler Individual Assessment Test Second Edition (WIAT-II) and again in 2009 to the Wechsler Individual Achievement Test Third Edition (WIAT-III) which is still in use as of 2018.
