CHEST X-RAY TWO VIEWS. REASON FOR EXAMINATION: Fever, aches and pains/flu-like symptoms. DISCUSSION: The lungs are well aerated. There is no evidence of any focal area of consolidation. A faint rounded density is seen in the base of the left lower hemithorax probably representing a nipple shadow.

X-rays make up X-radiation, a form of high-energy electromagnetic radiation.Most X-rays have a wavelength ranging from 0.03 to 3 nanometres, corresponding to frequencies in the range 30 petahertz to 30 exahertz (3×10<sup>16</sup> Hz to 3×10<sup>19</sup> Hz) and energies in the range 100 eV to 200 keV.X-ray wavelengths are shorter than those of UV rays and typically longer than those of gamma rays.
